

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
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
STEP 1:

Enter in your email address you used to login and the password you created. If you don't remember the password please press the 'Forgot My Password' link to reset.




STEP 1:

Visit www.careyuniversity.org and click the highlighted “Menu” icon on your phone.




STEP 2:

Click “Student Login”.




STEP 1:


STEP 1:



Click “Add Response” when finished.




STEP 1:

Click the "Upload Document" button and select the file you would like to submit.




STEP 4:

Click the red "X" button when you have selected your assignment file.




STEP 1:

To view chat messages, click the “My Chat” button. To view messages from your lecturers and important messages about your student account, click the “My Messages” button.




STEP 2:

To send a message, click the highlighted icon.




STEP 3:



- **Starting the search over again** - either by selecting the logo, searching again, or returning to the original bookmark
- **Clear cache** - You can do this by going into your settings in your browser and choosing “clear cache” in your privacy settings

The Improper Use of Resources – Plagiarism

The following paragraphs from the CIUT Academic Catalog constitute our policy on plagiarism:

Plagiarism is defined as: “an act or instance of using or closely imitating the language and thoughts of another author without authorization and the representation of that author’s work as one’s own, as by not crediting the original author.” Simply put, when one quotes from a source, or uses ideas derived directly from a source, without properly footnoting the source and listing it in the Bibliography, it is plagiarism. Random House Unabridged English Dictionary, “Plagiarism.” Random House Publishers, 2019. Any student whose work shows evidence of Plagiarism will receive an automatic failure for their research paper or thesis. If a student receives a failing grade for Plagiarism, the Academic Dean or Thesis Advisor will have the following options:

The student may be permitted to re-write portions of their research paper or thesis and receive a 25% grade reduction on their final submitted work. The student may be required to submit a new research paper, or choose a new thesis topic and therefore start the entire research and writing process from the beginning. The student may be removed from the degree program and issued a Diploma only.

Attendance Policy

Regular attendance is essential to academic success and full participation in the learning process. As such, students are expected to attend all scheduled classes and required academic activities.

To successfully complete a course, a minimum of 80% attendance is required.

- Students who fail to maintain at least 80% attendance in any course may not be eligible to receive a final grade.
- In such cases, the student will be awarded a grade of "INC" (Incomplete) for the course.
- The "INC" grade may only be resolved in accordance with institutional policy and at the discretion of the instructor or academic department.

It is the responsibility of each student to monitor their own attendance and communicate proactively with instructors regarding any absences due to illness, emergencies, or other valid reasons. Supporting documentation may be required.
